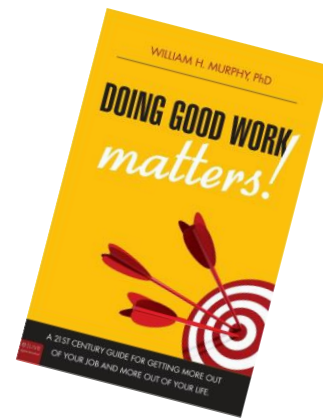


My Personal Bull's-eye List
